



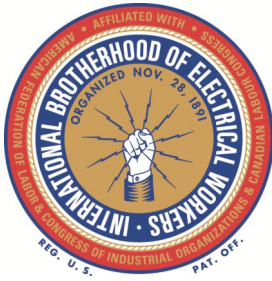
## IBEW/NECA Electrical Training for Inland Empire First Responders in Partnership with the Inland Empire Burn Institute

#### Curriculum: NFPA 70E

- NFPA 70E, *Electrical Safety in the Workplace*, prepares first responders to safely control the hazards they face, including arc flash.
- First responders entering areas with arc flash potential must be aware of the danger and the protocol that must be followed.
- Exposure to shock hazards and electrocution risks are common and real.
- First responders should be aware of the special hazards they may face when they encounter structures that have photo-voltaic (solar) panels installed on the roof.
- First responders should ensure that all first responders are trained in the recognition and avoidance of electrical hazards
